Background

- AD = genre (Taylor 2015)
- specific features, BUT: Such features have been identified particularly in the audio description of films and television programmes (Maszerowska, Matamala and Orero 2014)
- limited amount of work conducted so far on the audio description of art and the three-dimensional world of museums

- Text analysis and definition of museum AD features
- Creation of museum AD features "corpus"
- Definition of crisis points
- Creation of new museum ADs
 - National Archaeological Museum of Aquileia (Trieste)
- Translation of existing museum ADs, e.g.:
 - St. Paul's Cathedral | VocalEyes (EN > IT)
 - Selection of British Museum | VocalEyes (EN > IT)
 - Atalanta and Hippomenes | Anteros (IT > EN)
