# Visually impaired people in Serbia

- 12 000 blind or low vision people
- Organizations and associations of blind people in Serbia:
- Savez Slepih Srbije (The Union of the blind of Serbia)-Government organization
- Beli štap (White stick)-Non Government organization
- <u>Udruženje Homer (Homer Association)</u>- Non Government organization

#### AD in Serbia in the last several years

- Laws, regulations and policies/Only general principles.
- The Electronic media law-broadcasting, cable and developing media have to provide programs for deaf and blind people according to their own technical and financial capability.
- Public National Media Service –RTS-Radio and Television of Serbia- has to provide programs for people with disabilities
- The Law of culture-"to ensure accessibility of cultural activities for all"

#### • Film festivals

- Two dozen of national and international film festivals
- Only one mini festival is accessible for blind and low vision people-<u>Udruženje Homer (Homer Association)</u>since 2009-present days
- <u>http://www.udruzenjehomer.rs/</u>-about 80 films, non commercial, based on voluntary work and donations
- Branko Matic, the founder of Homer Association, and the first man in Serbia who realized the importance of AD, and his volunteers made audio description for those films.

### Broadcasting networks

•2011-2016-Once a month used to show AD film on RTS- initiative of Homer Association - Branko Matic, and his volunteers made audio description for those films on Public Media Service

#### • Theatres

- 2011-2016-Audio description for plays in the National Theatre in Belgrade (Narodno pozorište)-supported by the Union of the blind of Serbia
- Museums
  - Audio described exhibitions are rare, only few have come to exist in the last few years ( Museum of Zrenjanin, Matica Srpska Galery, Exhibition of Pavle Beljański paintings in National Library) Museum of contemporary art Belgrade (Muzej savremene umetnosti -May-June 2019) 12 paints are audio described.

## What needs to be done

- Laws and regulations have to be more precisely regarding audio descriptionespecially :
- The Electronic media law
- The Public Service Media law
- Culture Acts
- Filmmaking and distribution regulations

 Improving cooperation between organizations of the blind in Serbia Initiation of collaboration with organizations practicing AD on the Western Balkans Involving University (Faculty of Philology) and Association of interpreters of Serbia in this process
